MOUNT HOOD MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Once again the Park Commission has awarded the Mount Hood Memorial Park and Golf Course Management Agreement to Mass. Golf Management, LLC. The new contract term begins on January 1, 2008 and expires December 31, 2012.

GROUNDS AND CLUBHOUSE IMPROVEMENTS

The Park Commission and Mass. Golf Management, LLC are planning the following capital improvements during 2008:

- Installation of a clubhouse fire alarm system
- Insulating the Mount Hood Clubhouse
- Reconstruction and renovation of the clubhouse patio, stairs and landscaping

The Park Commission and Mass. Golf Management, LLC look forward to continued progress in improving Mount Hood Golf Course & Memorial Park for golfers as well as non-golfers.

PRIVILEGES AND RESTRICTIONS

1. **An individual applying for a resident membership** will be required to provide proof of residence in the City of Melrose to Mass. Golf Management and or the City prior to receiving his or her membership card.
2. **Membership fees** cover greens fees only; cart fees are not included.
3. **Weekday only memberships** are valid Monday thru Friday. They are not valid on holidays or during times blocked out for tournaments.
4. **Junior weekday only memberships** are valid Monday thru Friday, 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM. Junior members may reserve starting times between 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM one day in advance of play. Junior Memberships are not valid on holidays or during times blocked out for tournaments. Parents/guardians are required to check course availability prior to dropping off junior members.
5. **Full memberships** are valid Monday thru Sunday and holidays. They are not valid during times blocked out for tournaments.
6. **Family memberships** are open to two family members, living in the same household, who are age 19 or older.

7. **Starting times** are recommended, especially for weekend play. With the exception of junior members, members are permitted to reserve starting times up to six days in advance. On weekends, preference will be given to foursomes playing 18 holes. All members must check-in with the Pro Shop prior to their round(s).
8. **Alcohol:** Alcoholic beverages are only permitted in designated areas of the clubhouse and patio. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the golf course or in the parking lot. Violation may lead to revocation of membership and or expulsion from the course.
9. **Golf carts** are not allowed on public roads or in parking lots with the exception of the following crossing areas: Clubhouse to the 1st tee, 5th green to the 6th tee, and 17th green to the 18th tee.
10. **The Park Commission reserves the right to suspend or terminate the membership of any individual who violates these privileges and restrictions as well as any other policy.**
